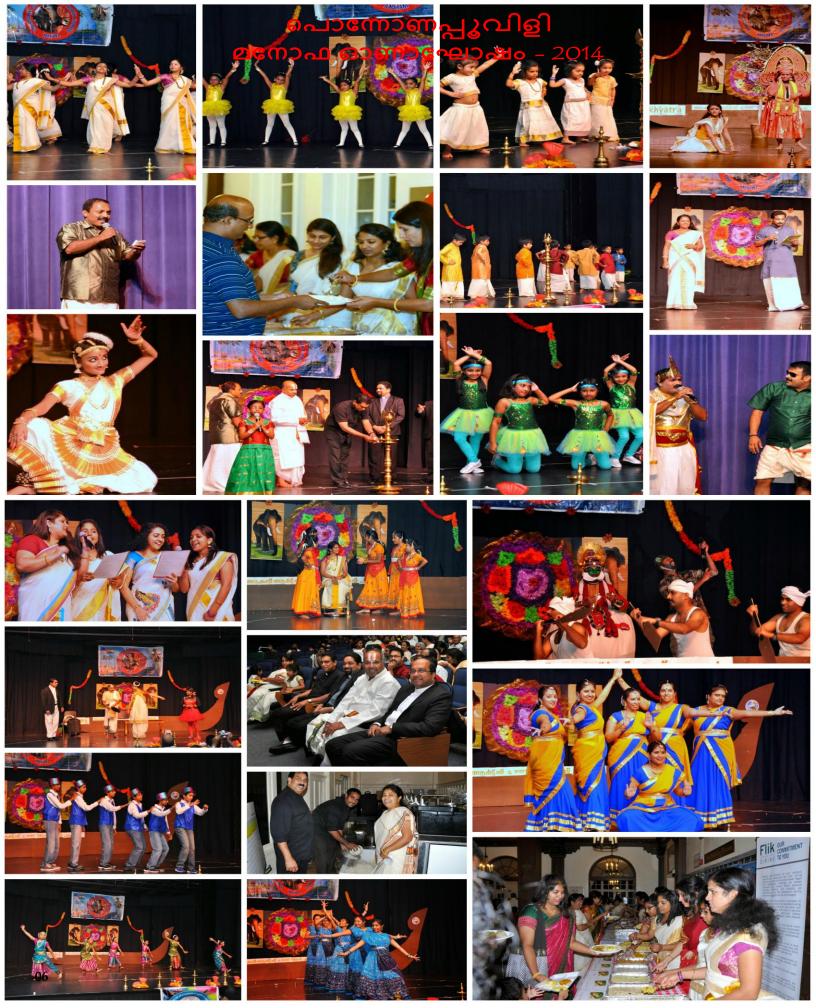

MONEY MATTERS (MM)

We all know our SSN. It never changes. Similar to the SSN, we have a 3 digit number known as our FICO score which always changes. FICO Scores is a complex calculation. However the data for the score falls into five categories. The percentages given below are important in determining your FICO score.

What makes up a FICO credit score?

Payment History	35%	New Credit Accounts	10%
Amounts Owned	30%	Types of Credit Used	10%
Length of Credit History	15%		

For those who have moved to the US recently, and for those who do not have a credit file it is important to start building your scores. How do we achieve that? Once you have a job go to some of the major retail stores and open an account. Be sure to make your payments on time. These days everything can be tracked on-line. Schedule your Outlook Calendar and make all payments on time.

Never try to max out any of your credit cards. Try to keep credit use to less than 30% of your credit limits the lower the better. This will help you get the best possible credit scores. In turn this should help keep you from getting drowned in debt.

You don't need to carry a balance on a credit card. Paying your bills in full each month keeps your financial score at the best. Some may disagree with me on this issue, but to me paying off your debt is better than accumulating debt. There is very possibility that a regular credit card may be denied to new comers and those with a bad score. In such cases, apply for the secured version. This requires you to deposit money with the card company and you will notice that your credit limit is usually equal to the deposit.

I would request all my credit card companies to make my payment date to a day of the month I am comfortable making payments. Imagine a date like 18th or 19th when you know there is sufficient money in your account. This means you can pay all your bills in one sitting.

How to get a free credit report? (Absolutely free). We all like the word free. Usually there are strings attached to free things. How to monitoring your credit report every quarter? AnnualCreditReport.com is the ONLY authorized source for the free annual credit report that's yours by law. Go to the above site. Create your user account. Remember your username and passwords. You will need this always. Pull only one report at a time. Imagine you begin with Experian in January, pull TranUnion in April/May and pull Equifax in Sept/Oct. Now come January pull from Experian. Follow the cycle and you are checking your credit absolutely free year round!!!

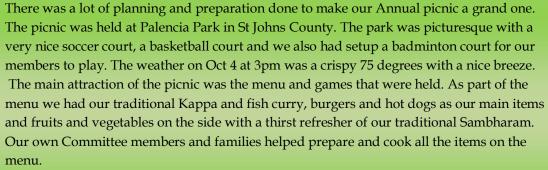








Manofa Picnic

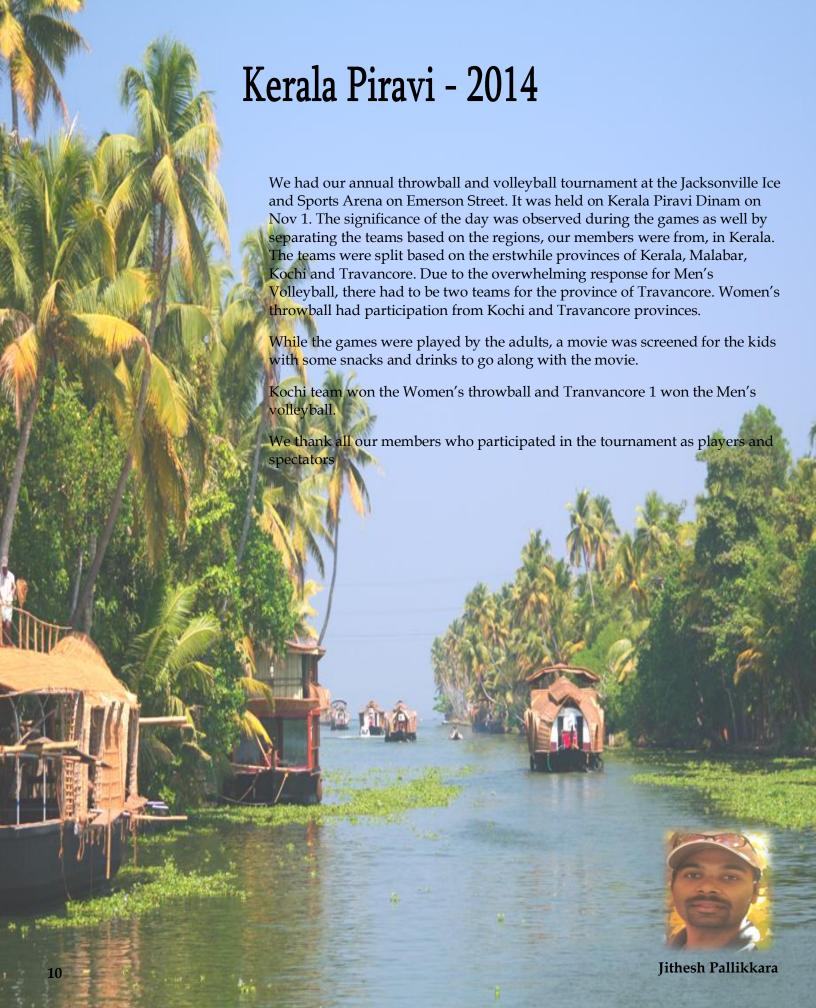

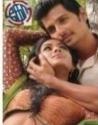
